Typically tests that do not reflect a child's functionality are not used during the early intervention process. Below is a list of the only approved assessments that can be used for Early Intervention. The most commonly used assessments are The Bayley Scales of Infant and Toddler Development Motor Scale, PDMS-II, The Sensory Profile, and the HAWAII.
