From a theoretical point of view, the effects of corruption on international trade flows are ambiguous. On the one hand, corruption may act as a barrier to trade increasing the cost of doing international business. Corruption And International Trade

Corruption in general hampers international trade, whereas bribe paying to customs enhances imports. This effect is most robust in importing countries with inefficient customs. High waiting times at the border significantly reduce international trade. The effects of unpredictability of corruption and policies are inconclusive.

Does corruption discourage international trade ...

Using the gravity model approach and annual data for the period 1998–2007, Jacob Musila and Simon Sigue´ show that corruption adversely affects international trade. Their estimates suggest that if a country with Africa's average corruption perception index of 2.8 were to improve its corruption level to Botswana's 5.9, its exports would improve by about 15 per cent and imports by about 27 per cent.

The United States and Brazil signed a new protocol on anti-corruption and trade facilitation as an update to the existing 2011 Agreement on Trade and Economic Cooperation (ATEC). Researcher and former oil industry executive Joe Roeber, in *Parallel Markets* (2005), estimated that 40% of corruption in international trade was related to the arms trade. This was based on a detailed survey of materials not in the public domain, relating to complaints of corrupt activities in international trade, to which he had access.

In Transparency International's 2016 Corruption Perception Index (CPI), Serbia ranked 72 of 176 compared countries, nearly unchanged from its ranking of 71 in 2015. In its 2016 progress report on Serbia, the EU said corruption remained a serious problem, and anti-corruption efforts had yet to yield meaningful results.
