### New York Spinal Cord Injury (SCI) Rehabilitation

The best chance for recovery of function following spinal cord injury is through prompt treatment. Early surgical decompression and stabilization leads to better recovery. Aggressive physical therapy and rehabilitation after surgery also maximizes recovery. The majority of recovery occurs within the first six months after injury.

The most common rehabilitation therapies for spinal cord injury patients are physical therapy, occupational therapy, and psychotherapy.
